PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would restore, protect, and enhance coastal wading bird, seabird, and shorebird nesting and foraging habitat on Egmont Key National Wildlife Refuge and Egmont Key State Park. Project activities would include chemical/mechanical removal of invasive vegetation, primarily coin vine; planting of native plant species; and installation of sand fencing to reduce shoreline erosion. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.
