Removal of Barriers on Sea Turtle Nesting Beaches along Florida's Gulf Coast

(non-preferred)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would restore and improve sea turtle nesting habitat by removing physical shoreline barriers on Florida's Gulf Coast nesting beaches. Physical barriers include manmade and natural permanent/semi-permanent barriers to nesting and hatchlings (e.g., dilapidated sea walls, storm debris) and non-permanent barriers (e.g., abandoned beach furniture, recreational equipment). The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the U.S. Department of the Interior would be the Implementing Trustees for this project.
