






Phase V.4 Florida Coastal Access Project: Dickerson Bay Addition



What We've Been Up To





Completed restoration planning on three plans aimed at restoring wetlands, coastal, and nearshore habitats and birds. These plans encompassed six projects for engineering and design and construction for the totaling over \$2.4B

Trustees have initiated development of seven new Adaptive Management activities totaling over \$36M



Project Implementation Plans Finalized Continue to implement the Sea Turtle Early Restoration Project components and the Colonial Waterbird Monitoring Project.






